SUMMARY	DECISIONS AND ACTION POINTS/ PERSON RESPONSIBLE
<p>1. Welcome and Minutes</p> <p>Welcome by Amitabh</p>	<p>Amitabh chairs the call.</p> <p>The Minutes were sent before the call.</p>
<p>2. Action 2015: May mobilization and FFD Campaign</p> <p>Ingo: The May mobilization is working fairly well. The original idea of GCAP with the Global Moves is implemented by different organisations in at least 60 countries. Fionuala leads the Action Team together with Ben from World Vision. There are 13 Days planned for different topics. There is a variety of issues included. This is the first broad based mobilization in action/2015.</p> <p>Amtiabh: In India there is a postcard action addressing the Prime Minister. By now we got more than 300,000 Postcards. We hope to reach 500,000.</p> <p>Ana: For 28th May we plan the day on Sexual and Reproductive Rights for Young Women. A number of countries plan to participate</p> <p>Biraj: We will share the plans for May 28 with Asian coalitions</p> <p>Amitabh: Amina’s Office created an informal group on Post-2015 in which different people participate - from Global Compact to UNDP to some civil society actors. He is part of the group.</p> <p>Ingo: For the FFD campaign there will be 3 major campaign phases. The first aims to bring Heads of States and finance minister to Addis. The second focus on national policy asks. And the third is a Global Day of Action on July 11th.</p>	<p>The National Coalitions of GCAP will be invited to join the day on Sexual and Reproduction of Young Women on May 28th.</p> <p>Amitabh will update the Global Council on the informal group.</p>

<p>Amitabh: It seems that the Indian and Chinese Finance Ministers are not planning to go.</p> <p>Ingo: We as GCAP Secretariat are working on a global petition. We contacted Avaaz. They are planning a petition on tax justice for the FFD conference. We can give inputs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Language, e.g. on gender from Rosa, from next Monday the FFD negotiations - In Milan a statement on FFD <p>As GCAP we might work on another petition after the FFD conference and towards the SDG summit.</p> <p>Ingo: There shall be Call for Proposals from action/2015:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Motivating People to apply 2. Offer to give feedback and inputs <p>Discussion: There are worried in LAC about the geographic spread</p> <p>FFD focusing on finance for Gender Equality. Having presence in Addis, making noise</p>	<p>The drafts from Avaaz shall be circulated.</p> <p>A statement in Milan could feed into the Avaaz petition.</p> <p>GCAP Secretariat shall explore the potential for further petitions.</p> <p>FFD shall be one of the central agendas in the GC call in June.</p>
<p>3. What comes after 2015?</p> <p>Ingo: There was a “Morning After” meeting at the World Social Forum in Tunis where Ashok, Claire and Ingo participated. Afterwards the informal “So Now What?” process worked on the development of draft objectives. So far Ingo participates. The process is open. Different networks and campaigns are involved.</p> <p>Amitabh: Comments on substance? Comments on the process? What would be our relationship with this new entity? How do we play a role in shaping?</p> <p>Salina: We shall have a more substantive discussion in Milan, what happens after September, what is our role beyond 2015.</p> <p>Amitabh: Processes are happening in parallel: The future of GCAP and other global cooperation. What would be the architecture? What are the worries? Process: Where are the Southern voices? Where are the women voices?</p>	<p>There shall be a more intensive discussion on the “So Now What?” process in the meeting in Milan beginning of June.</p> <p>We need to work to have strong inclusion and participation of Southern Voices and Women’s organizations in the “So Now What?” process.</p>
<p>4. Any other Business</p> <p>Milan Expo: Riccardo: GCAP Italy represents GCAP global in the preparation committee. He will come back to the participants for specific tasks and roles.</p> <p>Who is going?</p>	<p>Riccardo shall convene the group going to Milan. He shall proactively get inputs from others.</p>

<p>Marta, Rosa, Beckie, Salina, Richard, Salina, Ingo</p> <p>Amitabh: We need to circulate the Tunis minutes. Milan shall build on this. A smaller group shall prepare</p> <p>Follow up from the April call: We need to have a communication to the GCAP Constituencies on the process until the Global Assembly in September in New York soon.</p>	<p>An email on the Global Assembly shall be sent to the GCAP National Coalitions and Constituency Groups by Ingo.</p>
